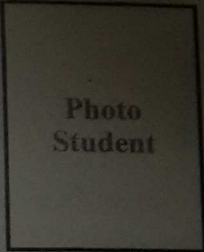

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**GENERAL RULES AND CONDITIONS (L.A.)****ELIGIBILITY**

- EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION** : The candidate should have cleared 10+2 or T.D.C. First year (in old scheme) with subjects Physics, Chemistry and Biology from Higher Secondary Board, Ajmer or equivalent, Candidates from Agricultural Sciences field can also apply.
- AGE** : Minimum eligible age 17 years. (Relaxation in maximum-age as per State Government rules and instructions)

SCHEME OF ADMISSION

A list on basis of merit would be prepared, in accordance with the rules and regulations as laid by the Government, from the submitted application forms. The last date of submission of application form and the date of issue of list/s should be inquired from the Admission Office. These selected candidates would be called for an interview and on basis of performance in interview and academics, admission would be granted. Call for interview does not guarantee admission. All relevant certificates and documents should be presented at the time of interview. The applicant will have to check for himself the list/s from the Office. On letter or call to the applicant will be made unless otherwise specifically mentioned. TA, DA, etc. will not be paid for the interview.

RESERVATION

Reservation as per Government policies will be provided.

COURSE

Course duration and contents will be according to the policies of State Government.

FEES - 50,000 By R.R. & D. R. N. N. N.

Fees are to be deposited within a period 7 days (including working and non-working days) from the date of admission, failing which the Admission Office reserves the right to cancel the admission and grant the seat to next deserving candidate. The fees for the first year are to be deposited at the time of admission. In addition to this a Bank Guarantee is to be furnished by the candidate disclosing his/her ability to pay the fees (this includes all fees and expenses, taking into account inflation, economic conditions etc., as demanded by the course coordinator) for the next two years. Fees for each year are to be paid before the next session starts to avoid any in-disciplinary action. No amount or deposit will be refunded after the admission. Enrolment/Registration fees as demanded by the State Government will also have to be paid by the candidates in addition of other fees.

DISCIPLINE

- ATTENDANCE** : A student must have 80% attendance in lecture and practical (individually.) In addition to this 90% clinical should be attended on an annual basis.
- Library and Laboratory rules have to be strictly followed. Copies of these rules can be availed from the office.
- DRESS CODE** : The admitted candidates will have to use uniforms prescribed by the School at their own expense. Students are expected to come neatly dressed to the School. The management reserves the right to prohibit any student looking clumsy and unkempt (dressed indecently.) Male students are expected to be clean-shaven everyday.
- Students are expected to treat all their teachers with utmost respect. Any complaint received from the faculty regarding indiscipline would be viewed very sternly by the management. A student may feel free to discuss/ask doubt/argue on a topic/differ with the faculty in his/her views, but care should be taken to see that no element of disrespect is reflected. Punishment for misbehavior or insubordination would be decided case to case but could be severe and may even mean rustication from the School.
- The student are advised to take care to the School properties their own. Students identified as responsible for destroying/breaking/misusing/rendering incapable anything belonging to the School would be fined a sum ranging from repairing charges to charges of replacement or both of the said property.
- Any issue/problem/irregularity should be brought to the notice of the Principal of the School Secretary/Vice President of the Society immediately.

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**RULES & REGULATIONS FOR THE STUDENT**

Every Student admitted to the G.N.M. in Dr. RADHA KRISHNAN NURSING INSTITUTE, JODHPUR should follow the rules & regulation given in the prospectus as well as orders given time to time by the principal.

- 1 . Every student should attend the classes & clinical or field and will remain in the institute or a place where practical is to be performed for the whole of the period also you should follow the orders given by the concern turor, those who are accompanying in clinical or in the field.
 - 2 . As per the rules & regulation of INC (Indian Nursing Council) Only the following leaves are granted.
 - (a) Sick Leave - 10 days/annum
 - (b) Annual Vacation - 30 days
(Deepawali vacation-8day+Summer Vacation-7days+Winter Vacation-8days
+ After final exam-7 days)
 - (c) Preparatory holiday - 7 days before exam
 - 3 . As per the RNC/INC rules, every student must have 75 % attendance in theory & Practical for appearing the annual examination.
 - 4 . The student those who are taking more than seven days leave without prior permission will be suspended. If a student suspended three times will take readmission.
 - 5 In case of illness, student will take permission from the Principal to remain absent from the classes and must submit the prescription by the Doctor or medial certificates before joining to the class, then will be consider as medical leave.
 - 6 . All the students will maintain the prescribed uniform of the Institute, Student will not be allowed without uniform. In Institute premises the uniform should be always neat and clean.
 - 7 . The student should reach the Institute before starting the class as per the timetable given time to time.
 - 8 . As per the INC rules, there will be internal marks of 25 % from the Institute. Every year it will be sent to R.N.C. before annual exam. The criteria for the internal marks will be as follows.

(a) Performance in the theory & Practical	(b) Attendance %
(c) Behavioral pattern with the staff, tutors & other students.	(d) Extra curricular activities.
 10. All the students should honesty & dignity of the Nursing Profession, and also they should maintain good conduct with the staff.
 11. The fee deposit will not refundable in any case.
 12. If any students misbehaves with staff/patients of the affiliated hospital during their practical classes, his/her name shall be struck off the institute list.
 13. In case of damage to equipment or any property of the affiliated hospital during practical classes, the concerned student shall be liable to compensate for all such damages.

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RULES & REGULATIONS OF THE HOSTEL

Every Student who are staying in the hostel should follow the rules & regulations given below.

- 1 . The student should stay in the hostel at all times except when attending the classes.

- 3 . If you want to go outside or to stay in case of illness you should take prior permission from the hostel supdt./warden. Night Stay outside the hostel will not be allowed.
- 4 . Regarding the leave first you must get sanction from the principal.
- 5 . All the student will be in the mess hall at exact time given in the time-table.
- 6 . No student will allow any visitor to enter in his room also prior permission of warden/hostel supt. if necessary to meet any visitors.
- 7 . Nobody will stand in the gallery and near to the window unnecessarily.
- 8 . After receiving the phone calls student will not the name of the person who made a call with time & date in the register.
- 9 . Any misbehaviour inside or outside the hostel with the staff or among themselves or any other will be taken seriously and suitable punishment will be given as per the seriousness & the situation.
10. The visitors will not allowed to take food from the mess.
11. The last date to submit the mess bill before 10th day of the next month.
12. Student are not permitted to use electrical appliances like "RADIO, TAP-RECORDER, HEATER, IRON ETC." If it detected appliances will be seized by the authorities of hostel and a fine will be levied.
13. Student should strictly maintain silence and should not move unnecessarily in the hostel.
14. Every student residing hostel should seek permission to leave hostel or going out to purchasing or any cause and write in out going register while going out of the hostel.
15. The warden's decision will be final taking disciplinary action student.
